

## PATH Walk gets donation match

Dozens of supporters gathered Saturday in River Park in Red Bluff for the annual PATH Walk to raise money for the organization, which provides relief for the homeless in the community.

Donations, raised through pledges made to the walkers, were down in number this year, but the amount raised grew thanks to an anonymous donor who agreed to match all donations up to \$20,000, according to event organizer Pam Klein.

The walk raised \$8,000 in donations, which will be doubled to \$16,000, Klein said.

Those joining the walk assembled around 10 a.m. Saturday and sang Amazing Grace before the Rev. Maryly Adair, of St. Peter's Episcopal Church, delivered the invocation.

The walk commenced to Main Street and headed north to the Cone and Kimball Plaza before returning to River Park.

Participants wore plain white T-shirts that indicated they were part of the solution to the problem of homelessness in Red Bluff.

PATH operates a woman's transitional home on Sale Lane PATH Sale House and establishes a winter shelter in several area churches.
